### SEASON 1926-1927

Let us not forget that for many years the *raison-d'être* of this Club was the holding of frequent competitions and that adherence to this policy has resulted in the development of the high standard of ski-ing of which we are justly proud. As a means of promoting a healthy and sturdy Canadian citizenship what sport can equal it? But much work remains to be done—we are far from the highest standards. So let us keep the faith.
