

Meanwhile the Arlberg-Kandahar may be regarded as a provisional substitute for a European championship. The Arlberg-Kandahar Cup was presented by the well-known Mürren ski club, the Kandahar, and it will be held in future alternately at Mürren and in the Arlberg. The Arlberg Ski Club has lent its valuable support to the British in the campaign for the due recognition of downhill races.

The competition in the Arlberg-Kandahar last March was extremely severe. I have never in all my experience seen so many first-class downhill runners together. There were eighty-six entries for this event, which was won by the German, Karl Neuner. There was also a very large entry for the Ladies' Arlberg-Kandahar, including the German and Austrian Lady Champions. Miss Elliott was, unfortunately, unable to compete but Miss Sale-Barker carried the British colors to victory. Her performance in the downhill race was magnificent, and she was over a minute ahead of the next lady. She won the Ladies' Arlberg-Kandahar Cup by an easy margin.

The present writer succeeded Mr. Gerald Seligman in the Presidency of the Ski Club of Great Britain on August 1 and I need hardly say that I shall welcome any opportunity of being of service to Canadian ski-runners visiting Europe or Switzerland both during and after my term of office.
