### C.A.S.A. INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP

AT THE last Annual Meeting of the Canadian Amateur Ski Association, various plans were discussed for increasing the income of the Association and one approved of was that of individual membership open to all skiers whether members of an affiliated club or not.

Our sources of revenue are limited and if we are to have an efficient national organization in a position to better promote ski-ing in Canada, and be represented at International and World Meets, we must build up a strong financial position.

The details and method of applying this idea to our advantage was left in the hands of the President and, at a recent executive meeting, the following plan of procedure was adopted:—

(1) That each Vice-President be asked to cooperate by organizing, promoting and supervising the campaign for membership in the C.A.S.A. in his own District.

(2) Membership fees will be as follows:—  
\$1.00 per annum, male or female, for any member of an affiliated club resident in Canada.

\$1.50 per annum for any non-resident skier or any unattached skier resident in Canada.

(3) With each membership will go an attractive badge.

(4) All issues of the Canadian Ski Bulletin will be mailed free to any addresses given, probably five copies during the season.

(5) A copy of the CANADIAN SKI YEAR BOOK, if desired, will be mailed for an additional fifty cents.
